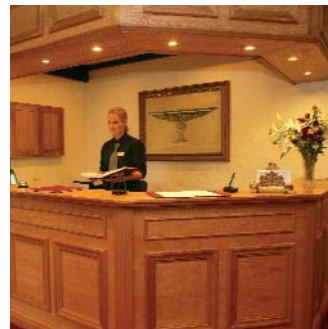

Welcome to the Newby Bridge Hotel. One of a small group of family run Lake District hotels where the emphasis is on friendliness and informality.



A bit of history

The Hotel was originally known as Newby Bridge Mansion. It was built in 1793 by James Machel and was one of the first great houses to be built on the shores of Lake Windermere.

The Machels were friendly with William Wordsworth and copies of correspondence with the great poet are displayed at the hotel, including a poem by Wordsworth "to Lizzie" which is dedicated to one of the Machel children. The literary connection has continued through the years as Arthur Ransome, author of 'Swallows and Amazons' was also a frequent visitor to the hotel.



A tasty treat

The hotel's kitchens are supplied with fresh fruit, vegetables and herbs from the proprietor's well known Victorian kitchen garden at Grange-over-Sands.* We also have our own farm which supplies the hotel with rare breed Herdwick lamb, Galloway beef and Tamworth and Middle White pork.

Where we can't grow it ourselves we use local supplies wherever possible. There is an excellent choice from a menu which changes every day and always includes choices for vegetarians.

You deserve a little luxury

Our leisure facilities include an indoor pool, ten person 'tylo' steam room, spa pool and gym. The facilities are exclusive to hotel guests and are not open to the public.

Newby Bridge Hotel has its own mooring on Lake Windermere and hotel residents may fish from here. For the less energetic, the hotel's Mediterranean gardens and terraces provide a tranquil refuge.

- Hairdryer and trouser press.

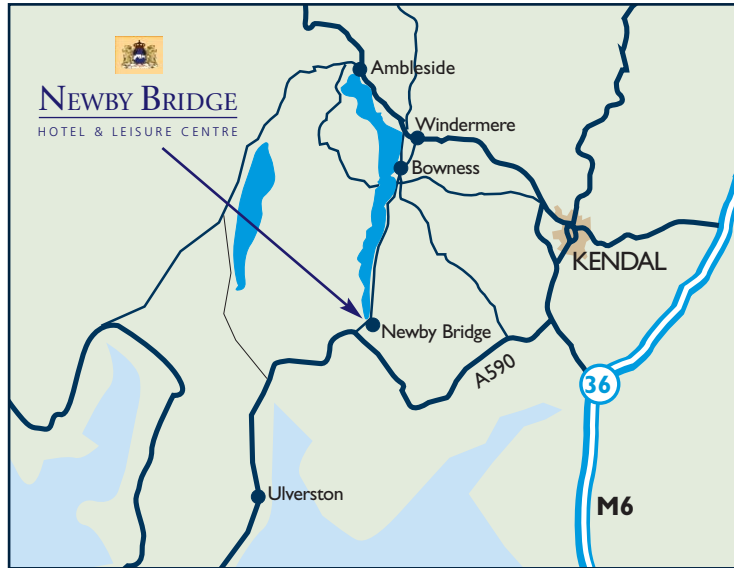
Comfortable settees, writing desks, irons and ironing boards may also be found in most rooms. Children are welcome and we have several Family Suites specially designed for parents with children.
